Notes:

A student's GPA is calculated from grades in Humanities, Science, Math, Foreign Languages, Logic and Rhetoric. All other subjects are non-GPA.

Math credits must include Algebra, Geometry and Pre-Calculus as a minimum.

Science credits must include general science, Biology and Chemistry as a minimum.

A student must have a minimum of 2 credits in a classical language.

A student must earn a minimum of 2 credits in a foreign language (grades 10-12) or 3 credits in one classical language (grades 9-12).

The PE credit may include a one-time .5 credit for participation in a varsity sport.
