Why Classical Christian Education?

Based on Douglas Wilson's book, "The Case for Classical and Christian Education," an Agape Christi spokesperson will highlight topics from it in a Socratic-discussion fashion. Topics will include the failure of public schools, the paideia of God, the problem with student evangelism in secular schools, the trivium, the importance of Latin, and the role of government in education. This is a great choice for those who are unfamiliar with classical education as well as those who are considering secular classical schools.

Making a Wise School Decision

Public school, charter school, private school, traditional Christian school, classical Christian school, home-school, internet school...does God care where your kids go to school? The Agape Christi spokesperson will lead you and your guests through Biblical mandates for making a wise school decision.
