BCS NOVEL CORONAVIRUS, COVID-19 GUIDANCE PLAN

Definition: The 2019 novel coronavirus is a virus that causes a potentially severe respiratory disease. It was recently identified in China and has spread to many parts of the world.

Level 1

Precautions:

- All faculty and staff will encourage and ensure that students use proper and increased "respiratory etiquette" through the following steps:
- **1.** Any student or staff who has fever, cough, or shortness of breath must remain at home for 24 hours or until they are symptom free.
- 2. Cover coughs or sneezes with a tissue or sleeve.
- 3. Frequent hand washing for at least 20 seconds.
- 4. Avoid touching face and others.
- 5. Alcohol-based hand sanitizer will be available when soap and water is not located nearby.
- 6. Classrooms will be supplied with Clorox wipes and other cleaning and disinfecting supplies that teachers will use daily.
- 7. Cleaning and disinfecting will occur daily to frequently touched surfaces and objects.
- 8. Sick students will be separated from the classroom and sent home.

Level 2

Recent travelers to affected areas:

- Students and staff who have recently traveled to infected areas will be asked to self-monitor for 14 days following their return.
- These students and staff will notify ADPH Infectious Disease & Outbreaks Division at 1-800-338-8374 upon return to Alabama and follow state guidelines.

Level 3

Increased reports of flu symptoms among students and staff:

- The office will monitor absenteeism and early checkouts due to flu-like symptoms.
- Should 10% (45) of the student body become infected with flu, BCS will close for a 14-day deep clean by a professional cleaning company.
- BCS administration will provide frequent communication with parents via RENWEB to inform them of reopening.

Level 4

Confirmed COVID-19

- Should a case of COVID-19 be confirmed, BCS will close indefinitely.
- BCS facilities will be professionally cleaned and disinfected and follow state guidelines and recommendations for reopening.
- BCS administration will provide frequent communication with parents via RENWEB to inform them of reopening.

Level 5

Severe Pandemic: Should COVID-19 spread, BCS will set up VOOM or other online teaching options for students to continue their studies from home.
