

## UPDATE #3 – March 16, 2020

PCS continues to follow the guidance and expertise of national and local health officials regarding COVID-19. Today, the President recommended limiting gatherings to 10 people or fewer and transitioning to remote learning in schools where community spread has occurred, which includes the Houston area. We have therefore decided that we will begin remote education March 23, which will continue through April 9, unless circumstances change drastically such that on-campus instruction is possible. If able, we intend to resume on-campus classes April 13.

The following provides more details about activities in the coming weeks:

- March 16 20
  - o Extended Spring Break for PCS students
  - Continuation of campus disinfecting
  - Closed campus except for faculty and staff as final preparations are made for remote instruction
  - Friday, 12:00 4:00 PM, families come to school to pick up books and materials according to the schedule below. Upper School students will be allowed into the locker hallway 10 at a time.
    - A E 12:00 1:00 PM
    - F-L1:00-2:00 PM
    - M R 2:00 3:00 PM
    - S Z 3:00 4:00 PM
- March 23 April 9
  - Education resumes with remote instruction (additional details to follow in the coming days).
  - o The PCS campus will remain closed except for essential personnel.
  - School operations will continue with calls and emails answered within 24 business hours.
